STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED] ORDER DISMISSING ADVERSARY PROCEEDING AGAINST CREDIT SUISSE LOAN FUNDING LLC

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2015, Plaintiff filed a First Amended Adversary Complaint for

(1) Avoidance of Unperfected Lien, (2) Avoidance and Recovery of the Postpetition Transfers,

(3) Avoidance and Recovery of Preferential Payments, and (4) Disallowance of Claims by Defendants ("Amended Complaint") (ECF No. 91) and thereafter served the Amended Complaint on, among others defendants, Credit Suisse Loan Funding LLC ("Defendant");

WHEREAS, the claims asserted against Defendant in the Amended Complaint concern certain transfers to Defendant totaling \$7,493.31 (the "**Transfers**"), which Plaintiff asserts were made pursuant to a certain term loan agreement, dated as of November 29, 2006, as amended by that certain first amendment dated as of March 4, 2009 (the "**Term Loan Agreement**");

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2015, Defendant filed an Answer to the Amended Complaint (ECF No. 242); and

WHEREAS, Defendant represents that, to the best of its knowledge, it did not receive any funds related to the Term Loan Agreement on or after June 30, 2009, other than the Transfers;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between counsel for the parties, that Defendant is dismissed from this adversary proceeding and any and all claims against Defendant arising out of the Term Loan Agreement are dismissed with prejudice.
